# Filing Date:

For an election to be held on a uniform election date, the election shall be ordered not later than the 78th day before election day.

An election ordered by an authority of a political subdivision that is not ordered for a uniform election date shall be ordered not later than the 62nd day before election day. This section supersedes a law outside this code to the extent of any conflict.

#### Filed with:

Maintained by the political subdivision who ordered the election.

#### Comments

Political subdivisions may appoint election judges, alternate judges, and early voting ballot board, at the same time that the election is ordered, or they may be appointed separately.
